AMSS Ambassadors play many roles, including:

- 1. Serve as AMSS links to Underserved, Diverse Older Members and Caregivers:

- 3. Provide Needed Services to their Respective Isolated Older Members and Caregivers: Offer transportation services; friendly visiting; friendly phone calls; deliver meals; or assist with handy work around the house; etc.
- 4. Promote the county's available resources and special health-related educational/training events, to the community as a whole: Disseminate flyers throughout their community centers; advertise county's events in their centers' weekly newsletters.
- 5. Play a leading role in AMSS Projects and Events. Participate in the initiation, development, and implementation of all AMSS projects and events.
